The government of West Bengal has <u>issued</u> an ex gratia of INR 5 lakh to the families of the deceased, with jobs for next of kin. The severely injured will be given INR 1 lakh as compensation, along with INR 10,000 for immediate needs, and INR 2,000 monthly for the next three months. The state government will also fund the education of 50 boys and 50 girls from affected families. The Indian Railways has <u>announced</u> a compensation of INR 10 lakh to the families of the deceased, INR 2 lakh to the grievously injured, and INR 50,000 to those with minor injuries. The PMO has promised a compensation of INR 2 lakh to the families of the deceased and INR 50,000 for the injured.
